DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This test is open to all dogs TWELVE (12) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Temperament Test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

ENTRY FEES

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per test

Payments must be cash or credit card, only. Credit card processing fee will apply.

No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

SIGN-IN

There will be a secretary table for check-ins and information day of test.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs, and/or their children. Any exhibitor, their dog and/or their Children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the sole discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Warren County Kennel Club of Ohio and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or children or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Warren County Kennel Club of Ohio reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog for any reason deemed appropriate by the trial committee. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Warren County Kennel Club of Ohio or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, Martingales, and body harnesses in the ATT. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of either fabric, or leather.

EXCUSALS

The evaluator will excuse dogs from the ring immediately if they show either any signs of aggression, or soil in the ring (urinate or defecate). Handlers may be dismissed for excessively talking to the dog, refusal to follow the evaluator's instructions, or for making corrections. The evaluator may discontinue testing if he or she determines the dog is too fearful or under duress to complete the testing.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season may not participate.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination
